







Introduction


Security Manager is entitled to change a payment authorization flow. For every company, the flow is set as assigned to specified 2-persons. One person creates a payment and next, another person authorizes it. However, the flow can be modified. This can be done in the main Self Service module.



- 1. In the main Menu, select the tab Self Service.
- 2. Now select the option Client Settings.




3. Click on the tile Client Settings and go smoothly through the option Flow Maintenance - New to the 3rd column and the tab All Flow Maintenance.




4. Select the service for which you want to modify the flow. For a flow for payments, select Payments. Click on the word DEFAULT next to it.










- 7. Having selected the appropriate level of authorization and number of authorizations, click on Submit.
- 8. The option Release required is a type of the next stage of verification after authorization. This is not payment authorization. A payment will be waiting for sending in the tab To Release. A payment can be sent by the person who has authorized it.

A different approach applies to authorization. Each authorization must be made by a different user.

9. After you have set your preferred levels, click on Submit.

The flow for payments will be re-directed to authorization.



10. Authorization will be carried out in a standard manner: the other Security Manager will find the new flow to be authorized in the tab Authorization.
